SUBJECT: Current Financial Report

DATE: October 4, 2023

To date, the OMA has received \$86,770.42 in income this year. The bulk of this revenue comes from three sources:

- 1. Membership dues;
- 2. Conferences/workshops; and
- 3. Sponsorship dollars.

The OMA received \$20,753 in membership dues. It has raised \$29,619 from registration fees for the summer conference and the spring workshop. In addition, the Conference Planning Committee raised \$23,500 in sponsorship dollars. Not reflected in this total is \$4,200 from the LOC Foundation and Wal-Mart which went directly to pay for scholarships for mayors to attend the summer conference.

The two largest expenses are the summer conference and LOC services. The summer conference venue fees and food and beverage costs were higher than the budgeted amount which means the OMA will need to utilize \$7,412.79 of its \$39,119 budgeted contingency to cover those unanticipated expenses.

Officers include the: President, President-Elect, and Past-President. All officers serve oneyear terms. The President-Elect automatically assumes the position of President and the President automatically becomes the Past-President.

The remaining six positions are classified as Director positions. Each Director position is a three-year term.

Pursuant to the OMA Constitution and Bylaws, persons interested in serving on the OMA Board of Directors is to submit an application to the OMA Nominating Committee. This year, all such applications were due on September 1, 2023. The Nominating Committee met on September 19, 2023, to review all submitted applications and presented a recommended slate of candidates to the OMA Board of Directors for the Board's review and approval. Included herein is the Memorandum from the Nominating Committee to the Board of Directors outlining the Committee's proposed slate of candidates (Attachment 1).
