FACT SHEET

- The Oregon Mayors Association (OMA) was established in 1972. The OMA constitution and bylaws specify several purposes for the association, emphasizing the need to increase the knowledge and ability of persons serving as mayor.
- The annual dues (shown below) cover professional management assistance provided by the League of Oregon Cities, such as board and business meeting assistance; conference planning and management; budget and accounting; marketing and communications; membership services; and quarterly newsletter production.
- The leadership of the OMA is vested in a board of ten directors made up of mayors from across the state. Board members are elected at the annual meeting of the OMA, held during the League of Oregon Cities' Annual Conference in the fall.
